USDTC Does not pay fees for trial entries loss administration fees for class entered. Instructor cards are not to be used for entry loss administration fees as of 1/1/2024. Entries close 5:00 pm Wednesday, Wed July 3, 2024, at the address of the Trial Secretary, after that time entries cannot be accepted and for cancelled entries will not be accepted. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to be advised as soon as practicable after the closing date should some cancellation not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is a contestant disqualified by a veterinarian or other person carried to the exhibition by action of the Trial Committee. Injuries or accidents, riots, fire, disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the exhibitor and its agent are not to be considered a reason for refund of entry fees. No entry fees will be added.

Bits in season - Entry fees will be refunded for entries that do not in season. Entries in season and the date of trial or written notification of cost is received by the Trial Secretary on or before July 1st.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Fees will be a full refund for all returned checks. Since the returned checks to the show exhibitors may result in their being out on a CAS ONLY basis. The Official Trial will be open to the exhibitor to the Saturday only and Sunday only.

Consent to the exhibitor for the time of the dog show. Does not pay any fee prior to their scheduled time of the dog show. Does not require for their exhibitor will be accepted. Exhibitors are not required to wait for dogs. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the exhibitor's dog. Dogs in the exhibitor's ring when their classes are called to be added. All dogs present at the dog show are allowed to their crates. Only dogs that are allowed to be shown under the American Cocker Spaniel rules are allowed on site. No un-entered dogs are allowed at the show site.

Included in the entry fees: At every licensed or member club obedience trial a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.50 Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog will be collected by the American Kennel Club for all Regular AKC classes (fees do not apply to Non-Regular Classes). A Recording Fee of \$0.50 will also be collected for each entry of a dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$ 3.50 shall be required for each entry of each dog. These fees are collected by the show giving club and are paid to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC Rule Effective January 1, 2024).

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged or for walk-throughs.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when judged.

NO EXERCISE PENS inside the building. The exercise area is in the front area with a fence around it.
