ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted and **WILL BE RETURNED**.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE** and **WILL BE RETURNED!**

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further Judging will be excused.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

DOGS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

In Preferred classes a dog MUST jump 4 inches lower than regular height. **In REGULAR classes Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in regular classes but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated**

DIRECTIONS

(Please use Google Maps – Mapquest is wrong)

From North (on SR-589 Toll S Veterans Expy): At Exit 10 (on SR 589), take ramp right and follow signs For SR-589 Toll South/Veterans Expy. At exit 9 on Veterans Expy, take ramp right for Gunn Hwy (CR 587 North) toward Sheldon Rd. Keep straight onto Citrus Park Dr to Sheldon Road. Turn left onto Sheldon Rd and go South approx. 1.7 miles. Then turn left onto Gardner Rd. (WATCH FOR SPEED BUMPS) Continue on Gardner going under the Expressway (**WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS WALKING**) and KETCH will be on the left (EXACTLY 1 MILE) – arrive at 7709 Gardner Road.

From South (on SR 589 Toll North Veterans Expy): At exit 7, take ramp right and follow signs for Linebaugh Avenue. Go approx. 1.8 miles on Linebaugh to Sheldon Rd. Turn RIGHT onto Sheldon Rd (CR 589 North) – go approx. 4/10 mile on Sheldon and turn RIGHT onto Gardner Rd. (WATCH FOR SPEED BUMPS) Continue on Gardner going under the Expressway (**WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS WALKING**) and KETCH will be on the left (EXACTLY 1 MILE) – arrive at 7709 Gardner Road.

If coming from Homestead Studio Suites come out of the hotel to Hillsborough Ave. Take LEFT and go under the overpass and take NORTHBOUND Veterans Expressway (SR 589). At exit 7, take ramp right and follow signs for Linebaugh Avenue. Go approx. 1.8 miles on Linebaugh to Sheldon Rd. Turn RIGHT onto Sheldon Rd (CR 589 North) – go approx 4/10 mile on Sheldon and turn RIGHT onto Gardner Rd. (WATCH FOR SPEED BUMPS) Continue on Gardner going under the Expressway (**WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS WALKING**) and KETCH will be on the left(EXACTLY 1 MILE) – arrive at 7709 Gardner Rd.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
